



## Articulation Agreement for SOKM

Global Christian University ([globalcu.edu](http://globalcu.edu)) has assessed the transferability of the School of Kingdom Ministry (SOKM) core curriculum. Daniel Goulet (Director) leads and assesses the program at SOKM and provided this detailed summary of the student learning environment.

The SOKM program has been assessed to have specific learning objectives and categories of learning. This is 26 weeks of instruction at 3 hours of direct lecture/discussion per week. Global Christian will accept a total of 6 semester units (9 quarter units) of undergraduate transfer credit. Term 1 or Term 2 of SOKM will each be awarded 3 semester units (4.5 quarter units).

### SOKM Program Description

The School of Kingdom Ministry (SoKM) is a 26-week supernatural ministry training program designed to integrate biblical theology, personal transformation, and practical ministry. Students are equipped to live 'naturally supernatural' lives by understanding and demonstrating the Kingdom of God through the power of the Holy Spirit. The program balances theology ('Word') and demonstration ('Power') through weekly teaching, activations, and ministry practice.

### Learning Outcomes

- Articulate a biblical worldview shaped by Kingdom Theology and the now/not-yet framework.
- Demonstrate understanding of identity and righteousness as foundations for supernatural ministry and integrate into ministry life.
- Operate in the gifts of the Holy Spirit—especially prophecy, healing, faith, and words of knowledge and wisdom.
- Apply the five-step prayer model to minister physical, emotional, spiritual healing and deliverance.
- Demonstrate Spirit-led compassion through power evangelism and relational ministry.
- Reflect theologically and pastorally on personal ministry experiences.

Outreach & Reflection Papers	Two written reflections (1–2 pages) from ministry experiences	20%
Midyear Reflection	Re-watch a teaching, submit 1-page reflection	15%
Final Integration Project	Written or oral presentation on personal transformation and ministry growth	15%

## Curriculum Details

- Teaching Team — Daniel Goulet, Putty Putman, Dianne Leman, Julie Yoder, Joanna Machen
- Primary Manual: School of Kingdom Ministry Student Manual by Putty Putman (255 pages)
- 26-week academic year (two 13-week semesters)
- Instruction is done through Distance education
- **Contact Hours:** 3 hours/week × 26 weeks = **78 instructional hours**
  - 1 hour – Teaching (Biblical and theological instruction)
  - 1 hour – Activation (practical ministry skill development)
  - 1 hour – Practice (application through Healing Rooms, Power Evangelism, prophetic labs, etc.)
- **Additional work:** Outreach, homework, reflections, and independent ministry activities
  - Equivalent to roughly **45–50 hours of student work outside of class**
- **Total learning hours ≈ 125–130**, the course receives **6 semester units** of transfer credit
  - *Kingdom Ministry I* (3 units) – Fall Semester
  - *Kingdom Ministry II* (3 units) – Spring Semester

\*Per TRACS guidelines, up to 25% of a degree may be transferred from an unaccredited institution. The AA degree can have up to 22.5 quarter units of unaccredited transfer. The BA degree can have up to 45 quarter units of unaccredited transfer.
