



Articulation Agreement for GSOM

Global Christian University has assessed the transferability of Gateway School of Ministry's (GSOM) core curriculum. Carol Cobb leads and assesses the program at GSOM and provided this detailed summary of the student learning environment.

Summary of GSOM Curricular Requirements assessed by Carol Cobb.

- Various class hours by well-equipped instructors (does not include books)
- Various Cohort hours and small group interactions guided or overseen by a leader.

The GSOM program has been assessed to have specific learning objectives and categories of learning. Each 9-month program has around 15 hours of lectures and instruction, supplemented by outside reading and cohort interactions.

Year one (level 1) of GSOM will earn students the following undergraduate credits

- 3 semester units of credit.

Year two (level 2) of GSOM will earn students the following undergraduate credits

- 3 semester units of credit.

Please note: The units can be used toward a degree at Global Christian University. These units will not convert to GlobalU units for transfer elsewhere. They will be used for internal accounting toward a degree, but will not be reflected on the GlobalU transcript if a student transfers before completing their degree.

*Standard residency unit requirements at GlobalU still exist. All GSOM units are treated as GE-level transfers.

*Per TRACS guidelines, up to 25% of a degree may be transferred from an unaccredited institution. The AA degree can include up to 15 semester units of unaccredited transfer credit. The BA degree can include up to 30 semester units of unaccredited transfer credit.
