



Articulation Agreement - LIFE School

Global Christian University has assessed the transferability of LIFE School's core curriculum. Students should request a LIFE School transcript with a list of courses. These units are unaccredited.

LIFE School runs on a 10-week quarter system with 4 quarters per year. The school has 8-10 hours of lecture, reading, writing, and homework per week.

Year 1 - Receive training and activation in identity, physical healing, emotional healing, deliverance, prophecy, and the Father's love. Learn to live a Kingdom lifestyle that integrates these into everyday life.

Year 2 - Teaching and activation in creating and establishing an apostolic culture, inquiry-based discipleship, and building high-performance, influential Kingdom teams that run as a family on the mission of Jesus.

Summary of LIFE School Curricular Requirements

- Undergraduate Level Transfer
 - Other TRACS institutions are assessing the 2-year LIFE school program as 30 semester units of transfer credit. (Other institutions break down 20 quarter units for year 1 and 25 quarter units for year 2)
 - 8-10 hours per week of lecture and homework is 4 units per semester.
 - **Year 1** = 4 semesters * 4 units = **16 units**
 - **Year 2** = 4 semesters * 4 units = **14 units (The maximum total amount of transfer is 30 semester units toward a BA degree.)**
 - GlobalU has a 90-semester-unit limit on transfer units for the BA program.
- Graduate Level Transfer
 - Other TRACS institutions are assessing the 2-year LIFE school program as 6 semester units of transfer credit. (FIU Agreement "At the MA level, students can receive "Advanced Standing" in their pursuit of a graduate degree, where it will be 15 classes instead of 18.")
 - **Year 1** = 4 semester * 1 graduate units = 4 units
 - **Year 2** = 4 semester * 1 graduate units = 4 units
 - However, GlobalU has a maximum **12-unit** transfer limit for graduate units (FIU has a 9-unit max)

The LIFE School offers courses in Biblical Studies, leadership, and ministry that align with GlobalU's educational standards.

- Standard residency unit requirements at GlobalU remain in effect. All LIFE School units are treated as lower-division-level transfer (or graduate-level transfer).

Please note: The units can be used toward a degree at Global Christian University. These units will not convert to GlobalU units for transfer to other locations. They will be used for internal accounting toward a degree, but will not be reflected on the GlobalU transcript if a student transfers before completing their degree.

*Per TRACS guidelines, up to 25% of a degree may be transferred from an unaccredited institution. The AA degree can include up to 15 semester units of unaccredited transfer credit. The BA degree can include up to 30 semester units of unaccredited transfer credit.
