



## Articulation Agreement for VETI

Global Christian University has assessed the transferability of Victory Outreach Bible College and Victory Education & Training Institute (VETI) core curriculum.

Students should request a VETI transcript with a list of courses and VETI-assessed units.

The AA and BA degrees at VETI are below the accreditation standards of hours. We do accept up to 25% of units toward a degree from non-accredited schools like VETI.

### Summary of VETI Curricular Requirements

- **VETI offers an unaccredited AA degree (24 VETI courses) (48 semester units)**
  - Classes are on 8-week quarters and meet 3 hours per week (24 hours per quarter for 3 units)
    - Summer classes only meet for 15 hours (SHOULD BE WORTH LESS UNITS)
    - Some 1-unit classes are taught for 8 hours
  - 2 years: 3 courses of 3 quarter units over 4 quarters per year (12 classes per year)
  - A total of 36+36= 72 quarter units
  - **ACCREDITED INSTITUTIONS REQUIRE 60 SEMESTER UNITS FOR AN AA EQUIVALENCY. (We accept a maximum of 30 semester units into our BA program.)**
- **VETI offers an unaccredited [BA degree](#)**
  - This 18-month, 42-quarter unit (28 semester units) program consists of 6 Modules.
  - **ACCREDITED INSTITUTIONS REQUIRE 120 SEMESTER UNITS FOR BA EQUIVALENCY. (We accept a maximum of 30 semester units into our BA program.)**

The VETI program offers courses in Biblical Studies, leadership, and ministry that align with GlobalU's educational standards.

- Credits from VETI transfer as semester units
  - Standard residency unit requirements at GlobalU remain in effect. All VETI units are treated as GE-level transfers.
- AA and BA degrees from VETI do not transfer because they may be below accreditation standards of 60 or 120 semester units, respectively.
  - We can only accept a maximum of 30 semester units.

The VETI BA is sufficient to be admitted to the GlobalU Master's program if the student has completed a total of 120 semester units of college-level work.

Please note: The units can be used toward a degree at Global Christian University. These units will not convert to GlobalU units for transfer elsewhere. They will be used for internal accounting toward a degree, but will not be reflected on the GlobalU transcript if a student transfers before completing their degree.

\*Per TRACS guidelines, up to 25% of a degree may be transferred from an unaccredited institution. The AA degree can include up to 15 semester units of unaccredited transfer credit. The BA degree can include up to 30 semester units of unaccredited transfer credit.
